**Theme: UNDERSTANDING THE DEMANDS OF BUILDING MY FAITH (PART 5)**

Faith failure is equals to life failure (Romans 1 vs. 17; Galatians 3 vs. 11; Hebrews 10 vs. 38). However, to keep faith growing, believers must ensure that they:

1. **Beware of going after other gods** (2 Timothy 2 vs. 19; Psalm 16 vs. 4; Psalm 62 vs. 5; Exodus 20 vs. 4 - 5; Psalm 34 vs. 5). Corruption of destiny starts with stepping into a wrong place and allowing the environment penetrate. As a child of God, we are not expected to be in unholy alliance with ungodly, else destiny will be truncated.

Being spiritually awake is vital to building and living a robust faith-based life. It is being spiritually sensitive that helps believer's recognise representation from an alternate altar, with the potential of representing other gods.

2. **Beware of evil conscience** (1 Timothy 1 vs. 19). You must have a pure and a good conscience to God and to men, and avoid negative and defiled conscience accustomed to doing evil.

Any tradition that does not have its roots in the word of God should be discarded.
